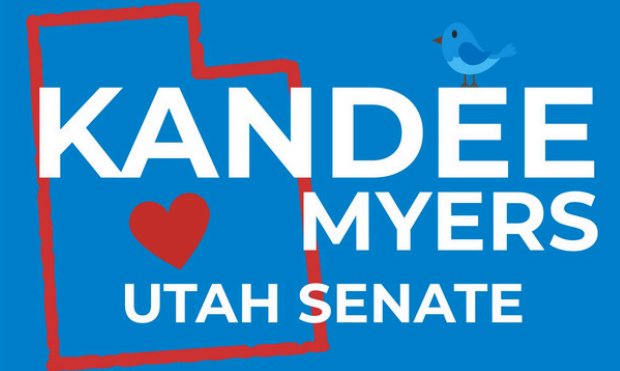


# Why I am Running
